Application Validation for Graduate Student Council Representatives

The Graduate Student Council General Council is composed of:

- Four Constitutional Officers (President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer);
- Standing Committee Chairs;
- Council Representatives
 - One Department Representative for every 100 students (or fraction thereof, rounded up) in each graduate department and program;
 - One Representative from each of the graduate residences (selected by the government/officers of the residence)
 - Two Representatives living off-campus
 - Five At-large Representatives (with specific appointments decided by the General Council)
- Institute and non-Institute Committee Representatives (non-voting in the General Council, but always welcome to share updates from their committees)

The GSC Bylaws provide for a nomination procedure whereby an individual must submit a nomination petition in order to be considered a voting member of the GSC General Council. In the absence of opposition, submission of the petition is sufficient to join the Council. Should there be more than one candidate for an available position, the student organization of the department or living group will, in conjunction with the Secretary of the GSC, conduct an election with the winner being the new representative from the group.

The term of office extends one year beginning October 15. Current representatives may seek re-election without filling out the Validation form; however, if other candidate applications are submitted before October 1, an election involving the current representative may occur if there are insufficient Representative slots for the number of nominees.

NOTE: Some departmental student organizations have separate elections coordinated as part of their own leadership transition. For those departments, as indicated on the GSC website, the timeline and procedure is determined by the department.
